

Continuing Professional Development for secondary music teachers with options for accreditation

Listen Imagine Compose supports teachers by developing their skills and confidence in teaching composing through research and Continuing Professional Development. Featured in Music Teacher Magazine and at music education conferences nationally and internationally, Listen Imagine Compose "has played a significant part in improving the musical and educational understanding of professional musicians, teachers and academics" - Mark Philips, HMI Music, 2012.

Accredited **CPD** for secondary music teachers is now available which develops skills in teaching composing with KS3, GCSE and A level students.

- The courses is delivered locally in partnership with local hosts;
- The course is accredited by Birmingham City University at Level 7 (Certificate/ Diploma/ Masters);
- Students can be a mix of those who do and do not wish to be accredited, subject to a minimum of 6 being accredited;
- The year-long programme comprises 6 x 3 hour sessions plus additional time spent undertaking action research in the classroom and reflection on professional practice.

During the course teachers:

- Reflect on what composing with young people entails;
- Learn new creative strategies for teaching composing;
- Develop pedagogic strategies for teaching composing;
- Develop existing schemes of work;
- Undertake Action Research;
- Are mentored by a leading academic and teacher trainer;
- Work with professional composers;
- Network and learn from other secondary music teachers participating in the CPD.

Costs

- Stage 1: Most teachers embarking on the Listen Imagine Compose CPD will have sufficient prior learning to gain accreditation at Stage 1 at no cost (eg PGCE). Other credits gained at level 7 from other relevant courses may be transferred for £50. Accreditation of Prior Learning (if no university credits) entails completing additional modules; the cost for this is £600/module.
- Stage 2: Most teachers embarking on the Listen Imagine Compose CPD will start here. Cost: £2,200 if accredited.
- Stage 3: Professional Practice Enquiry (accredited learners only): £2,200.

How the accreditation works

Cost: there may be a cost involved in verifying and accrediting prior learning by Birmingham City University. This has to be done on a case-by-case basis but as an example, most PGCE courses undertaken in the last 10 years can be accredited for no cost; transfer of credits gained at MA level from other relevant courses may be transferred for £50. Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (when no university credits) entails completing additional modules; the cost is £600/module.
